With a Researcher's help, Abhijeet can more easily keep track of important current political actions and issues so that when he's out there speaking to his constituents, he can be as knowledgeable and informed as possible about what matters most.

A Researcher works with the Communications & Marketing Manager and their team to make sure that communications and marketing efforts are current, relevant, and hard-hitting. **A Researcher is digging into the issues of the day both in Parliament but also in the wider political environment** and sharing back relevant findings to Abhijeet and his team.

A Researcher's main tasks include:

- Researching voting patterns in parliament
- Collecting data as needed (example: compiling a list of all local news outlets)
- Researching and compiling brief reports on current issues

A Researcher should be able to:

- Conduct basic internet research on political and societal topics
- Synthesize large amounts of information into short, accessible formats that are easily consumed and understood
- Advise the candidate and campaign leaders on most pressing political, societal, election, and riding issues
- Commit to attending regular bi-weekly campaign meetings (evenings only)
- Access the internet and be relatively responsive on the team Slack
- Work well remotely and in-person with a variety of other people
- Keep organized records and communication channels using available online tools
- Take on a sense of pride, accomplishment, and ownership in the success of research efforts in the Beaches-East York provincial campaign

Time commitment: The position will require a minimum commitment of 3 hours a week.
